Hutt City Council is exploring options for the Petone Library and Heritage Centre on Britannia Street.

The current building needs work, and Council's Annual Plan is proposing \$1.5m be spent on repairs in 2021-2022. Meanwhile, we're keen to take this opportunity to step back and consider the bigger picture. We want to make sure the facility meets the current and future needs of the Petone community.

We're looking at several options which range from repairing and refurbishing the existing building, to replacing it with a multi-purpose facility which would offer more community spaces and services.

We're also considering options for housing as part of the facility, given the current City-wide shortage, and a redevelopment that provides better connections to the surrounding civic areas.
